

The Summit School Literacy Counts Program



Literacy Counts provides highly-trained Summit tutors to the Boys and Girls Clubs in Annapolis and to the Stanton Community Center. The tutors teach reading weekly from September through May in one-to-one sessions at these centers.

How do we assess progress?

- Students are tested to assess progress bi-annually.
- The directors of each center evaluate the success of each student's program annually.
- Progress reports are written describing the objectives of the tutorial program and the progress of the student semi-annually.

Funding the program:

Foundations and individual donors have made the Literacy Counts program possible since its inception in 2008. Summit's Executive Director donates her time to monitor and evaluate the program throughout the year. Funding pays for professional tutorial sessions, a coordinator, and materials.
